Prof. Ajantha Dharmasiri is the Director and the Chairman of the Board of Management of the Postgraduate Institute of Management (PIM), University of Sri Jayewardenepura, Sri Lanka. He also serves as an adjunct professor in International Human Resource Management at the Price College of Business, University of Oklahoma, USA. He is the Honorary President of the Institute of Personnel Management (IPM), the largest HR professional body in Sri Lanka. He was recently appointed as a Vice President of the Asia Pacific Federation of Human Resource Management (APFHRM).



He has over two decades of both private and public sector working experience in diverse environments including Unilever and Nestle. He has engaged in consultancies in fifteen countries in Africa, Asia and the Middle East. He serves in the Boards of National Institute of Business Management (NIBM), Softlogic PLC, Citizens Development Business Finance PLC (CDB), DSI Samsons Group and the Association of Management Development Institutions of South Asia (AMDISA).

He is a Commonwealth AMDISA Doctoral Fellow and a Fulbright Postdoctoral Fellow. He holds a Ph.D. and an MBA from the Postgraduate Institute of Management, University of Sri Jayewardenepura and a B.Sc. in Electrical Engineering from the University of Moratuwa. He is a Chartered Electrical Engineer and a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Management, UK as well.

As an academic scholar, he has presented research papers at key international conferences and is the editor of Sri Lankan Journal of Management (SLJM), the pioneer local publication that became the first to be hosted by EBSCO global research database. He has published articles in local and foreign journals, and is also an author of six books. He has won many accolades including gold medals for best papers in two international management conferences, Emerald best paper award in 2014, and in 2010, the Platinum Award by the Alumni of the Postgraduate Institute of Management (PIMA) for outstanding academic contribution. He also won the prestigious IPM Lifetime Gold Award 2014, the highest honour for an HR professional in Sri Lanka.
